#### CALL TO END DEPORTATION OF HAITIAN ASYLUM SEEKERS

The RJM USA-Haiti Province joined with numerous other organizations and individuals to call on our government to halt the deportation of Haitians seeking asylum in the USA. In the name of the province, our Leadership Team helped to finance the placement of an ad in *The Hill*, a publication that targets members of Congress and the Administration, demanding an end to the practice of denying a hearing to those fleeing violence and poverty.

The text of the ad, together with its supporters, is below and also attached to the Bridges email:

We call on President Biden and Secretary Mayorkas to halt all removals to Haiti immediately. The humanitarian crisis in Haiti continues to worsen. The United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights stated in May that, "Armed violence has reached unimaginable and intolerable levels in Haiti."

The numbers are shocking. The administration has removed 26,000 Haitians since taking office, well over **24,400**<sup>2</sup> just since September of 2021. At least **9,000** of those removed have ended up in Port au Prince, which has seen an explosion of violence between warring gang factions.<sup>3</sup> Adding thousands of refugees into this situation is cruelty without measure.

No other president has removed so many Haitians in such a short period of time.<sup>4</sup> Additionally, since October of 2021, the Coast Guard has interdicted at least **7,137**<sup>5</sup> Haitian migrants at sea. In most cases, they have been immediately returned to Haiti.

Human rights organizations and Members of Congress have repeatedly called on you to stop these expulsions. The United States should uphold its asylum laws and protect Haitian refugees, not send them back to the extraordinary dangers they will face.

Stop the removals!
